- Read some individual letters by saying the sound for them.
- o Enjoying singing songs and rhymes.

Maths: As mathematicians we will learn ...

- o To take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- o To count to 10.
- To develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects (subitise).
- o To match numerals and amounts up to 5.
- Explore 2D shapes.

Understanding the World: As explorers, we will learn ...

- I can make connections between the features of my family and other families.
- I can begin to make sense of my own lifestory and family's history.
- o I can notice differences between people.
- I can talk about members of my immediate family and community.
- I can name and describe people who are familiar to me.

Communication and Language: As communicators we will learn ...
