Literacy: As readers and writers, we will learn ...

- To engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- To use our phonic knowledge to write words and sentences that can be read by others.
- o To form lowercase and uppercase letters correctly.
- o Blend sounds into words to read.
- o Recognise and read harder to read words.
- Spell words by identifying and then writing the sound.
- To plan what they want to write by talking out loud then trying to write using sounds they know.
- To write short sentences using capital letters and full stops.

Physical development: As movers we will learn ...

- To develop the foundations of a handwriting style which is fast, accurate and efficient.
- To use core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or on the floor.
- To confidently use a range of large and small, indoor or outdoor apparatus, independently or in a group.
- To develop and refine a range of ball skills, including throwing, catching, kicking, passing and batting
- To develop small motor skills to use a range of tools competently.

Understanding the World: As explorers, we will learn ...

- o To plant seeds and take care for growing plants.
- To understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all things living.

Communication and Language: As communicators we will learn ...

- To be able to express a point of view and to debate when we disagree with an adult or a friend, using words as well as actions.
- o To hold conversations when engaged in backand-forth exchanges.
- To use talk to work out problems and organise thinking and activities and to be able to explain how things work and why they might happen.
- To ask questions to find out more, to check they understand what has been said.
- To express my ideas and feeling about my experiences using full sentences, including the use of past, present and future tense and making use of conjunctions.
