What does the Designated Safeguarding Lead do?

The School Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) is the first point of contact for any member of the school community who has a concern about the safety and/or well-being of a child. They undertake additional training every two years so they know how to refer concerns to the appropriate investigating agencies and can offer support and advice to all members of the school community. They are responsible for maintaining a record of any concerns and report directly to the school's governing body.

What is PREVENT?

Prevent is about safeguarding people and communities from the threat of extremism and providing early intervention to protect and divert people away from being drawn into terrorist activity. At our school it is about being vigilant to changes in behaviour which may be a result of families or communities painting the world as black and white by highlighting division and difference and exploiting fears based on ignorance or prejudice.

Education is a powerful weapon against this.

The Federation of Fairfield and Colneis will equip our children with the knowledge, skills and experiences to think for themselves and in everything we do we will promote an understanding of the values we share: democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect for and acceptance of those with different faiths and beliefs.
