Holiday Activity & Food Programme – explainer for parents

- This government funded project is all about providing fun activities & meals for school age young people from 5 to 16 in East Suffolk
- Eligibility for this includes those who are on Free School Meals, assessed to be in need by local authority, young carer, looked after child, come from a low income households and not in receipt of free school meals, on an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- East Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council work with different providers to coordinate fun activities (with lunch) for young people to participate in
- HAF funding can only be taken up by young people on free school meals or other factors above – programmes can also have places which people can buy privately
- Activities take different forms – including sports, cooking, arts, adventure
- This provision is for Christmas, Summer and Easter holidays

How to see what's available and to book

- Bookings are done on the booking system Eequ – no HAF codes required now
- Please visit www.eequ.org/suffolkhaf to see what programmes are available
- Select the programmes and dates you want to attend and who is attending
- It will ask about HAF eligibility (i.e. Free school meals or other qualifying factors) and once the booking request has been submitted, this will be reviewed and eligible bookings approved by the HAF Team
